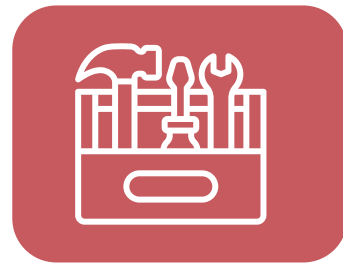

IMPACT

For the 201 people impacted in 2025, a safe home meant more than repairs—it meant dignity, stability, and the ability to stay where their life happens. Through 519 projects completed in 104 homes, HopeBUILDERS removed barriers that made everyday living unsafe, from failing systems to inaccessible entrances.

Each project helped prevent falls, displacement, and crisis—especially for older adults living on fixed incomes and people with disabilities with limited options for support. Our work bridges the gap between housing, health, and independence, ensuring people are not forced from their homes due to preventable conditions.

In 2026, HopeBUILDERS will build on this momentum by investing in stronger systems, growing volunteer engagement, and responding to increasing demand—so even more neighbors can remain safe at home.

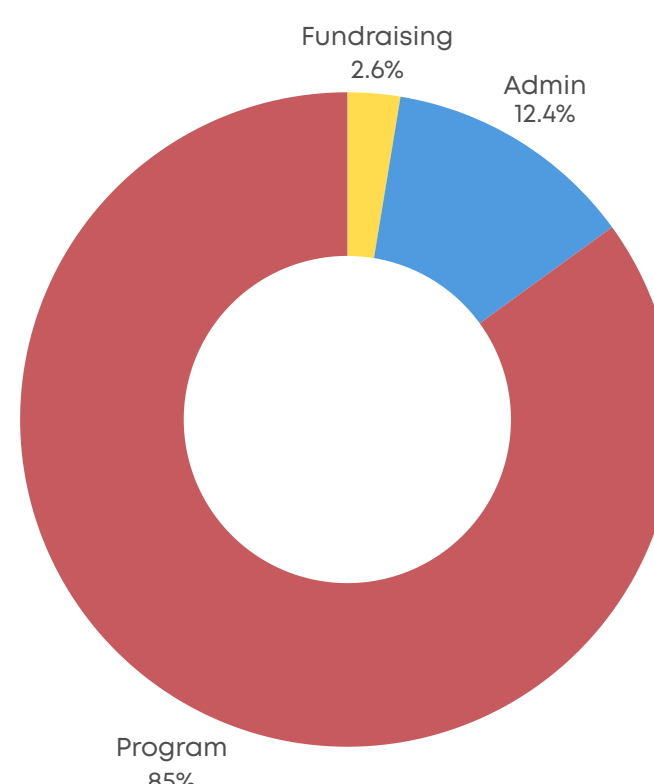
